Good morning,

Visual observations for Cyanobacteria were taken at Sears Park and adjacent property this morning (see attached report with images). The water was relatively clear (Secchi disk reading of 1.2m) and had a predominantly brown tint. No surface scums, mats, or films of cyanobacteria were present. No surface accumulations were visible at any of the observation points.

The public swim area at Sears Park remains OPEN for swimming.
